Ann was the first of the sisters to pass away. She died at age 52 and is buried in the old Myatt graveyard, now the private Preuit Cemetery.

With the parents gone, their children probably figured "Why not?" when the 1852 wagon train of 300 set out from NW Alabama, headed for Waco, Texas. At least one of their Waco homes is open to visitors.
